

## OLDEST YOU SAY?

### **In the nation ...**

Swarthmore College: "For nearly 100 years, the Honors Program has embodied Swarthmore's commitment to dedicated learning"

UNC Pembroke: "the program is the nation's oldest honors program"

University of Oregon: "Robert D. Clark Honors College. Founded in 1960, it is the oldest honors college in the United States"

### **In the nation, with one caveat ...**

University of Missouri: "home to *one of the oldest* Honors Colleges in the country"

Regis University: "*one of the oldest* Honors Colleges in the nation"

University of Central Arkansas: "*One of the first* Honors Colleges (in contrast to numerous Honors Programs) in the country"

University of Maine: "Since the early 1930s, the University of Maine has been able to boast that it had *one of America's oldest* Honors Programs"

University of Colorado at Boulder: "*one of the oldest* honors programs in the United States"

Western Michigan University: "Lee Honors College, *one of the oldest* honors programs in the nation"

University of Texas: "Founded in 1935, Plan II [liberal arts honors program] is *one of the oldest* honors programs in the country"

Long Island University: "LIU Post's Honors Program began in 1963, includes over 350 undergraduates in all majors, and is *one of the oldest* honors programs in the nation"

Washington State University: "Founded in 1960, the WSU Honors College is *one of the oldest* honors programs in the United States"

University of Utah: "home to the U's thousands of students participating in *one of the nation's oldest* Honors programs"

University of Arkansas: "Established in 1955, The Fulbright College Honors Program is *one of the oldest* honors program in the country"

Worcester State University: "Our program is *one of the oldest* Honors programs"

University of Delaware: "*One of the oldest* Honors Programs in the U.S."

Kent State University: "Is *one of the oldest* Honors programs in the country. Established in 1933 in the first wave of honors programs (1920s-30s)"

Kansas University: "KU has *one of the oldest* honors programs in the nation. The honors experience at KU goes back to 1929, with the inauguration of the Summerfield Scholars"

James Madison University: "*one of the oldest* honors programs in the country"

Valparaiso University: "1967. Christ College, the *third oldest honors college* in the United States, is founded"

University of Southern Mississippi: "has *one of the oldest* Honors Programs in the country; the Honors College was founded in 1976, but we have had an honors program since the 1960s"; "*sixth oldest* honors college in the nation"

Boston College: "oldest honors program *in a business school* in the nation"

### **In the nation, two caveats ...**

University of Georgia: "*one of the nation's largest and oldest* Honors Programs"

University of Toledo: "Jesup Scott Honors College was founded in 1963, making it *one of the oldest* honors programs *at a state university*"

Michigan State University: "Honors College at Michigan State University is *one of the oldest* honors programs *at large public universities*, having been established in 1956"

Hanze University of Applied Sciences: "honors director of *one of the oldest* honors programs in the Netherlands" (*the priority disease has spread!*)

### **In the region ...**

University of Central Missouri: "The second-oldest honors program in the Midwest"

### **In the state ...**

Clemson University: "Established in 1962, Calhoun College is the oldest honors program in South Carolina"

Northern Arizona University: "Northern Arizona University Honors Program is the oldest honors program in Arizona"

Mississippi State University: "oldest honors program in the state"

### **In the state, with one caveat ...**

Westminster College: "*second-oldest* honors program in Oregon"

Mercy College New York: "*One of the oldest* Honors Programs in New York State"

William Paterson University of New Jersey: "*one of the oldest* honors programs in New Jersey"

### **In the system ...**

Lamar University: "Honors Program was inaugurated in the fall of 1963 and is the oldest honors program in the Texas State University System"

Brooklyn College: "Scholars Program, established in 1960, is the oldest honors program in the City University of New York [system]"

University of Buffalo: "University Honors College at UB, the oldest honors program in the State University at New York system"

**In the system, two caveats ...**

College at Brockport: "*one of the largest and oldest* honors programs among the four-year SUNY comprehensive colleges"

**On campus ...**

Xavier: "Honors A.B. is the University's first and oldest honors program"

University of Alabama Birmingham: "University Honors Program is the first and oldest honors program on UAB's campus"

Purdue University: "Liberal Arts Honors Program (the oldest Honors Program at Purdue)"

University of Tennessee: "College Scholars Program is the oldest honors program at UT. Founded in 1973"

Xavier University: "Established in 1948, the Honors AB program is the oldest honors program at Xavier University"

**On campus, with one caveat ...**

University of Alabama at Tuscaloosa: "Mallet Assembly Men's Honors Program was established in 1961 by Dr. Blackburn and stands as the oldest honors program *still in existence* at the University of Alabama"

**In the university's college of ...**

Ohio State University: "oldest honors program at the Fisher College of Business"
